
The Church Year



The Church Year begins with the 4 Sundays of Advent. Christmas follows on the 25th of December, with the Christmas season next, ending with Epiphany. There are a variable number of Sundays after Epiphany, ending with Transfiguration Sunday, immediately before Ash Wednesday and the six Sundays in Lent. Passion/Palm Sunday begins Holy Week, which ends in the Triduum (Maundy [from Latin mandatum "Commandment"] Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday). Easter occurs on the first Sunday after the first Full Moon following the Vernal Equinox. There are seven weeks in the Easter season, ending with Pentecost. Holy Trinity begins a variable number of weeks after Pentecost (also called ordinary time), which ends with Christ the King Sunday, the last Sunday of the Church Year.
