2. Always say God's name with love and respect. (Not in vain)
3. Honor the Lord by resting and going to worship on Sunday. (Keep the Sabbath holy)
4. Love and respect your parents and all the adults in your life. (Honor them)
5. Do not hurt anyone through your actions or words. (Do not kill)
6. Always be faithful and respectful to yourself, your family, and your friends. (Do not commit adultery)
7. Do not take anything that is not yours. (Do not steal)
8. Always tell the truth. (Do not lie)
9. Be happy with the relationships you have. Do not be jealous of other people. (Do not covet people)
10. Be happy with the belongings you have. Do not wish for other peoples' things. (Do not covet things)
